J.A.M.

J.A.M. (Jesus And Me) is a program run for children pre-school and primary age. It runs during part of the Sunday morning service and is led by capable people from the church congregation.

BOY'S RALLY

Boys 7 years and up can attend. It takes place Wednesday night, at the church at 6:45pm. The programs include hobbies and crafts, badges, games, singing and devotions. Rally has been running in NZ since 1944.

"4G' Youth

Is a varied youth program for teenagers held each Tuesday evening, usually at the church. It is run by a competent team of youth leaders and includes games and social activities as well as bible teaching and encouragement to build strong Christian character.

Adults

Adults are catered for via Home groups, Ladies Bible Study and Seniors Groups. All these groups encourage friendship, fellowship and meet either weekly, fortnightly or monthly.

Health and safety

The following guidelines will ensure your child is safe during their time at mainly music.

In case of fire -

Follow the instructions of the mainly music leaders and exit the building in an orderly manner. Meet in the assembly area of the carpark.

In case of earthquake -

Move to interior side walls and drop, cover, hold.

Fire and earthquake drills involving everyone are held on a regular basis throughout the year.

Sickness

Please do not attend mainly music if your child has had vomiting, diarrhea or any other contagious infection.

We request that older siblings who may be off school for any of the above not attend the session.



What does a mainly music session look like?

The music session is 30 minutes after which morning tea is offered for both children and caregivers/parents.

For the children -

The music sessions are a mixture of body percussion, rhyme, movement, instruments and more.

We are helping your child enjoy music, learn to 'find' the beat of the music, participate in a program that has some structure and more. Your child will reap the benefit of increased motor skills, fine motor co-ordination, vocabulary, speech, and socialisation.

For the parents/caregivers –

An opportunity to participate with your child/ren in each action songs, rhyme and activity.

A time to connect with other parents/caregivers who are perhaps at the same life stage or those that have already been there.

Get involved!

The more involved you are, the more likely your child will participate. If they are too small to do the actions help them become involved by holding their hands and don't be concerned if all they want to do is explore the room. We're OK with that!
