

Many of you have been requesting information on Dr Serge after our last report when he was in considerable pain with kidney stones. Since then he has been drinking large amounts of water and has had no more pain. He recently had more scans which show the stone has moved on to his bladder and so he is continuing to drink large amounts of water in an attempt to flush it out naturally. Ben reports “Over the Easter period CDLA organized two seminars simultaneously, in Lwanza (400km) and in Kashobwe (328 km).

In Lwanza, the women teachers, Isabelle, Jeanne, Cathy, Adèle, plus Fidèle and André, have taught the course “Knowing God”. Mimie was in charge of selling literature and taking pictures. 125 women attended the seminar from the stations Kasolo, Mutabi, Shamwana and Lwanza. 17 people received Jesus. The last day, 975 people celebrated Easter with the CDLA team, and 73 people were baptized.

In addition to teaching, Fidèle met with and encouraged to the chaplain of the hospital and the person responsible for Sunday school. They gave him reports about their activities.

In Kashobwe, André Kapwasa, Malemba, Chola, the Legal Representative Mukalay and Benjamin taught the course “Living the Gospel”. Mubanga was dealing with the sale of literature. 427 people attended the seminar from Mukupa, Kahindu, Kisonkobwe, Nsomoka and Kashobwe. The Easter day, 807 people attended the worship service. 14 people received Jesus and three people confessed their sins. Sunday afternoon, André Kapwasa taught 25 young people about the Doctrine of the Brethren Church. Benjamin made a contact with the Leaders of Kashobwe Churches about the organization of a women’s conference in 2020 during the Easter period.
