Our travel back to D R Congo went smoothly. Our visa status was under threat as rules for visa's has changed. We were not sure if we may have been turned back at the boarder! However with the help of immigration contacts the potential refusal of entry was not applied in our case! Thanks for the prayers

It was heart-warming to be so welcomed by our Congolese colleagues. Lots of hugs and vigorous hand-shakes followed by a shared meal prepared by the team.

The teaching teams have already conducted 5 bible conferences this year. Two teams will depart this Saturday for a further one-month tour that will involve 6 conferences One of the first conferences will be held in Northern Angola This involves a journey of 900 km to the west of our base at Lubumbashi.

The translation team has recently translated the "Knowing God" course into the Chokwe language. This serves the area of Southern Katanga and Northern Angola. The office staff are busy finishing the printing and production of the teaching manuals. (See photo attached)

The blessing of our 4WD drive vehicles for these journeys is appreciated. Our fleet of 3 Land Cruisers allows us to negotiate roads that would otherwise be impassable.
